Recommended Arrival Time for Iberia Flights

International Flights (Most Iberia Routes)

For Iberia flights departing Chicago (usually international):




Arrive at least 3 hours before departure

This allows enough time for:


- Check-in and baggage drop
- Security screening
- Passport control
- Boarding procedures

Why 3 Hours Is Important

International travel involves extra steps:

-  Document verification (passport/visa)
-  Longer security lines
-  Boarding gates closing earlier

Iberia Check-In Deadlines at Chicago Airport

Here are general guidelines:

- **Check-in counter closes:** ~60 minutes before departure
- **Boarding gate closes:** ~20–30 minutes before departure
