



How long before flight time i have to be at Chicago airport for Aer Lingus airline flight

If you're flying with Aer Lingus from a Chicago airport such as O'Hare International Airport, arriving on time is essential to ensure a smooth check-in and boarding process.

How Early Should You Arrive?

For most international flights with Aer Lingus:

- **Arrive at least 3 hours before your departure time**
